2. This form must be filled out completely and neatly, including course title and number as listed on transcript.
3. When noting that a course has been completed, please write in the grade you earned in that course under the column "Completed."
4. If you have completed the checklist with an advisor in the Office of Academic Advising and you make a change in a required course you intended to take you must notify the advisor of that change.

Students should discuss their intention to minor in psychology with the department's undergraduate advising coordinator by the end of the junior year and inform the Office of Academic Advising of their intention to complete a minor.

Six courses, including three (3) of the five core introductory level courses and three additional courses in psychology. At least two of the required courses must be at the 300 or 600 level. No more than one research or reading course may count toward the minor.
