The board and the Office of Academic Advising authored this guide to help the community better understand ethical principles and procedures.

The policies in this guide apply to all undergraduates in the Krieger School of Arts and Sciences and the Whiting School of Engineering, even when they take courses in other university divisions. Students from other divisions enrolled in courses at Homewood are expected to follow the same principles of ethics included herein. They are punishable by the Homewood Ethics Board, as well as by their home institution. Professors are encouraged to contact the associate dean of student affairs to discuss options for handling violations that involve multiple divisions.
