What is a CIC?

Career and Internship Connections are off-campus career and interview fairs scheduled during winter break, so you have the time to travel to the cities you might be interested in. There are a couple of different ways to navigate the fairs, the best and most proactive one is to register, upload your resume, and APPLY for positions by the November 30th deadline. You may then be selected for interviews by employers, select a time and be interviewed at the event.

These innovative off-campus events allows students to network and interview with companies in New York, Washington DC, Chicago, Boston, Los Angeles. This is the 11th year of the consortium events (it includes 15 other schools). Last year's events boasted over 200+ employers in EVERY type of field.
