Hopkins provides...

Buildings A & B and the AMRs

Desk with carrel & light, chair, wardrobe, dresser, mirror, extra-long twin bed, trashcan, and telephone

*All furniture is movable and stackable, but may *not* be removed from the room*

Wolman

Desk with carrel & light, chair, wardrobe, four stackable drawers, mirror, extra-long twin bed, trashcan, and telephone

What to bring to your dorm room...

Here's a list of things we suggest bringing to keep you happy at Hopkins. Keep in mind you don't have to lug everything from home, there are plenty of stores in the Baltimore area to buy items from.

Clothing Essentials:

- Enough clothing to last between washes
- Athletic clothes
- Warm and cold weather clothing
- Bathing suit and beach towel
- Suit or formal wear
- Laundry basket/hamper
- Hangers
- Laundry detergent, fabric softener, dryer sheets
- Umbrella and rain gear
- Sneakers, sandals, dress shoes

Bedroom Essentials:

- Sheets & covers for XL-twin bed
- Pillow

Bathroom Supplies:

- Toiletries
- Shower shoes
- Shower caddy
- Towel and washcloth
- Hair dryer

Electrical:

- Computer (don't forget all the cables!)
- Printer
- Stereo
- Portable fan (especially for the AMRs)
- Extension cord
- Surge protector
- Camera
- Alarm clock
- Batteries
- Desk lamp
- Cell phone and charger or calling card

Miscellaneous:

- Sporting supplies (Frisbee, lacrosse stick, soccer ball, etc.)
- Musical instrument
- Bicycle (with a good lock)
- Health insurance card
- Flashlight
- Small dry erase board (for your door)
- Posters, pictures, & REMOVABLE adhesive
- School supplies
- Photo ID
- First Aid kit with Medicine and vitamins
- Small tool kit

Space is limited in the dorm rooms, so don't over pack. It can be a good idea to get in touch with your roommate before getting to campus to discuss who will bring bigger items, like a TV or stereo, so your room doesn't end up being too cramped.



Be aware that some items are not allowed in the dorms, especially items like halogen lamps, candles, incense, and non-flame retardant wall hangings (including nylon flags). The housing department would appreciate it if you do not pack these items for safety reasons.
