Thank you guys for your interest/email and thank you for waiting patiently for the responses. Classes will start soon (by next weekend preferably) and so we are providing the following information. THIS SEMESTER we are holding not the regular certification classes for CPR/First Aid/AED, but we are establishing INSTRUCTOR training courses for CPR/First Aid/AED. After successful completion of these classes, the students will have certifications in all three: CPR/First Aid/AED and become INSTRUCTORS licensed in teaching and certifying others in CPR/First Aid/AED. Due to a large amount of interest and limited spaces for future instructor positions for our club, we will only select FOUR individuals who express immediate interest in our classes. So if you guys are REALLY interested in becoming instructors, you will have to email us as soon as possible (since it will be first come/first serve basis) and you have to be committed to the following:

- * Classes will be held on Homewood campus
- * Attendance and participation are required for EVERY class.
- * Classes will be either 7 or 6/5 Saturdays that you have to commit to and the classes will be 5-6 hours long (depending on the pace of the students)
- * The class hours for now might be from 10am-3pm (subject to change depending on the students' as well as instructors' availability...we'll keep those interested updated/informed)
- *Must pass all the written and practical exams

This is a really big commitment but also a Great opportunity to those interested in helping out community, getting certified in all three areas as well as becoming instructors and also great LEADERship experience. After completion of the program, one of you will also be offered the BOARD position for being the head CPR/First Aid/AED instructor for JHU RED CROSS since all of the instructors this year will be graduating a semester early. So those interested in obtaining a BOARD/Leadership position for JHU RED CROSS for the next term will be given the opportunity to do so. After completion of the courses, the chosen head instructor along with the other instructors will become the next team to teach and certify others for JHU Red Cross.

(ALSO for those who asked: American Red Cross certifications in CPR/First Aid/AED are different from HERO/HERTU).
