**Incident Type:** Unarmed Robbery

**Location:** 2700 block Lovegrove Street, Baltimore, MD 21218

**Date:** October 24, 2013

**Time:** 7:40PM

**Summary:** A JHU nursing student was walking north in the 2700 block Lovegrove Street when she was approached by two suspects. Suspect #1 asked if she had any money, at which time the victim gave the suspect \$15. Suspect told the victim if she had a cell phone give it to him. At this time a neighbor was riding a bicycle toward them at which time the suspects fled the area. Victim was not injured. BPD and Campus Security canvassed the area for suspects with negative results.

**Suspect Info:**

Suspect #1- B/M, 20-23 years of age, 6', slim build, wearing a dark jacket with a red flannel shirt underneath. No further description

Suspect #2- B/M, 20-23 years of age, 6', muscular build, black leather jacket with a gray hooded sweat shirt underneath. No further description

Be aware of your surroundings. Walk with a sense of purpose with your head up, observant of your surroundings. Don't talk on your cell phone or text while walking. This lack of attention draws the interest of criminals.

Be a good witness and describe exactly what occurred with as many details as possible. Pay attention to the robber's appearance and demeanor. Give complete descriptions such as sex, race, age, height weight, hair color, scars, tattoos, and clothing. If a vehicle was involved try to get the make, color, and license plate.
