Incident Type: Unarmed Robbery

Location: 2706 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, MD 21218

Date: April 1, 2014

Time: 6:18PM

Summary: A JHMI affiliate was sitting on a bench at a bus stop in front of 2706 St. Paul Street when suspect #1 who was sitting next to him asked "What time is it?" The victim pulled out his cell phone from his jacket and told him the time. While putting his cell phone back into his jacket pocket, suspect # 2 who was behind the victim put his arm across the victim's chest and stated "Give me your phone & wallet." The victim gave his phone to suspect #2 at which time suspect #2 also grabbed the victims gray bag which was on the ground in front of him that contained personal papers. Both suspects then fled the area and were last seen running eastbound in the 100 block E. 27th Street. Victim was not injured. BPD and Campus Security canvassed the area with negative results.

Suspect Info:

Suspect #1: Black/Male, 20's, Black T-shirt, blue jeans - NFD,

Suspect #2: Black/Male, 20-25 years of age, 5'11", short hair, red & white striped short sleeved shirt with a gray thermal shirt underneath, khaki pants

Be aware of your surroundings. Walk with a sense of purpose with your head up, observant of your surroundings. Don't talk on your cell phone or text while walking. This lack of attention draws the interest of criminals.

Be a good witness and describe exactly what occurred with as many details as possible. Pay attention to the robber's appearance and demeanor. Give complete descriptions such as sex, race, age, height weight, hair color, scars, tattoos, and clothing. If a vehicle was involved try to get the make, color, and license plate.
