The below summary is an update to the Security Alert issued earlier today at 4:33 am

Summary: In reference to our Security Alert issued earlier today of an assault and robbery which occurred off-campus on 28th Street between Maryland Avenue and Charles Street, Baltimore Police has informed Campus Safety & Security that this incident is being investigated as a robbery between acquaintances. The victim was targeted due to an on-going dispute concerning money.

Crime Tip: Avoid walking alone at night, do not walk while distracted, such as talking or texting on your cell phone. Walk in well-lighted areas; make use of the Blue Jay Shuttle and security escorts. Call Campus Safety and Security at 410-516-7777 if you see any suspicious activity.
