The Fellowship Program is grounded in ambulatory care training and administration, and also features the opportunity to work in hospital-based settings that include Brigham and Women's Hospital and Children's Hospital Boston. Dana-Farber has several ambulatory care satellite facilities and is currently building a new ambulatory care facility, offering Fellows additional opportunities to learn about health care planning, capital expansion, and the clinical business development process.

The Dana-Farber Administrative Fellowship has been designed to provide:
