Instructions

Complete the attached Student Registration Form. Read all information below. Keep this instruction sheet for your reference.

Turn in the attached Student Registration Form and resume no later than 12pm, November 20, 2009. If you are selected for the trip a nonrefundable \$100.00 deposit is needed to hold your place, due by 12pm, December 4, 2009. **If you do not meet this deadline, your space will be forfeited to a student on the waiting list.** Financial Assistance may be available to those who qualify.

The trip is limited to 25 students due to space limitations incurred by our hosts in New York. Space on this trip will be generally allocated on a first-come, first served basis, however, professionalism of students' resumes and overall GPA will factor into selection should the number of students applying exceed our limit. You will be notified of your selection via e-mail on November 24, 2009.

Once Students Have Been Selected

Turn in an Intersession registration form, filled out for "International Development and Policy" (190.319) **to the Career Center (NOT to the Registrar's Office)** with your \$100 deposit and signed release form by noon, December 4, 2009. The Career Center will submit your pink slip along with a list of students who are eligible for the course to the Registrar's Office, and you will automatically be registered.

If you are selected, you will need to submit your resume to the **INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT & POLICY** Trip Resume Drop through your J-Connect Account no later than Friday, December 4, 2009. The remainder of your balance (\$150) is due Wednesday, December 16, 2009 at noon.
