

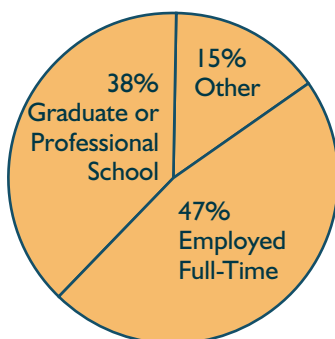
## About the Survey

The Class of 2006 Post-Graduate Survey of undergraduates in the Krieger School of Arts & Sciences and the Whiting School of Engineering, conducted by the Johns Hopkins University Career Center, was completed in December 2006. Graduates were contacted via email, beginning in May 2006, to complete an online survey. Throughout the summer, the Career Center repeatedly invited recent graduates to take the online survey. An additional attempt to collect data was made in collaboration with the Office of Annual Giving. The Phonathon contacted 2006 graduates via phone to collect information from those who had not yet taken the survey online. Altogether, 619 members of the undergraduate Class of 2006 (59% of the class) responded.

# Class of 2006 Employment

Nearly half (289) of all survey respondents reported that their primary activity in the Fall 2006 would be full-time employment. Of the remaining survey respondents who reported a primary activity other than full-time employment, 25% reported that they would also be working, and an additional 5% were actively job searching.

## Industry Information

273 graduates who reported that they would be employed full-time also provided the industries in which they would be working.



## Salary Information

Starting salary information was provided by 166 of the 289 survey respondents who reported that full-time employment would be their primary activity after graduation.

## Internships

Internship information was gathered only from respondents to the web-based phase of the survey. 79% of these respondents reported having had at least one internship while at Hopkins.

**30%** had one internship

**31%** had two internships

**23%** had three or more internships



Most respondents (87%) did at least one of their internships during the summer. The next most popular time was during the spring semester (45%) followed by the fall semester (43%) and then intersession (25%).
