

# *Global Civil Society: An Overview*

Drawing on the findings of the Johns Hopkins Comparative Nonprofit Sector Project, this report provides a broad overview of the civil society sector in countries spanning all six inhabited continents and includes just-released data on developing countries in Africa, Asia, and the Middle East. The report:

- Provides a comparative overview of the civil society sector in 35 countries:
  - **Africa:** Kenya, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda
  - **Asia:** Japan, Pakistan, Philippines, South Korea
  - **Europe:** Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, U.K.
  - **Latin America:** Argentina, Brazil, Colombia, Mexico, Peru
  - **Middle East:** Egypt, Israel, Morocco
  - **Others:** Australia, U.S.
- Analyzes the scope, size, composition, and financing of the sector, including new data on nonprofit employment, volunteering, expenditures, and revenues.
- Examines geographic patterns and characteristics of the nonprofit sector.
- Presents data in dozens of easy-to-read charts.
