A LIST OF SUGGESTED ITEMS TO BRING

Hopkins provides...

Buildings A & B and the AMRs

Desk with carrel & light, chair, wardrobe, dresser, mirror, extra-long twin bed, recycling bin and trashcan

Wolman and McCoy

Desk with carrel & light, chair, wardrobe, four stackable drawers, mirror, extra-long twin bed, recycling bin and trashcan

*All furniture is movable, some is stackable, but may *not* be removed from the room*

What to bring to your dorm room...

Here's a list of items we suggest bringing to Hopkins. Remember to consider the environmental impact when purchasing any item. When possible buy used or do not buy at all. And, if you just cannot live without it, make sure to check out the hyperlinks below that will help you make the green choice.

Personal Items:

- [Clothing, enough to last between washes](#)
 - Athletic clothing
 - Warm weather and cold weather
 - Formal wear (i.e. suit)
 - Sneakers, [sandals](#), dress shoes
 - Bathing suit and beach towel
- Laundry basket/hamper
- [Hangers](#)
- [Laundry detergent](#) and dryer sheets (for an environmentally friendly option try detergents that are corn or coconut oil based)
- Umbrella and rain gear
- Sheets & blankets for XL-twin bed ([bamboo sheets](#) are eco-friendly and antibacterial, great for weeks you forget to do laundry)
- [Pillow](#)
- [Toiletries](#)
- Shower shoes
- Shower caddy
- Towel and washcloth
- [Hair dryer](#) (consider coordinating with your roommate for purchasing of one)

Electronics:

- [Computer](#) (don't forget all the cables!)
- Portable fan (especially for the AMRs)
- Camera
- Alarm clock
- Batteries (buy [rechargeable](#) so you'll never have to run to the store when they run out)
- [Cell phone](#)
- [Power strip](#) (Consider getting a [smart strip](#). (check first for JHU Power Strip requirements))

Miscellaneous:

- [School supplies](#)
- Sporting supplies (soccer ball, handkerchief, lacrosse stick, etc.)
- Health insurance card
- Posters, pictures, & REMOVABLE adhesive
- Photo ID
- First Aid kit with medicine and vitamins
- Small tool kit

Transportation:

- [Bike](#)
- Bike Lock

Space is limited in the residence hall rooms, so don't over pack. It can be a good idea to get in touch with your roommate before getting to campus to discuss who will bring bigger items, like a TV or [refrigerator](#), so your room doesn't end up being too cramped.



Be aware that some items are not allowed in the dorms, especially items like halogen lamps, candles, incense, and non-flame retardant wall hangings (e.g. nylon flags). The housing department would appreciate it if you do not pack these items for safety reasons.
