

The “DO NOT Pack” List

Items not permitted or not recommended for your residence hall room:

LAMPS

- Halogen lamps are a fire hazard and are prohibited in the residence halls. If you are unsure what a halogen lamp or light bulb looks like, please look at the pictures below.
- Plastic decorative lamps such as the tri-colored lamp below are not recommended for residence hall rooms. They have been known to melt, and pose a fire threat as well.



HOOKAHS, INCENSE, CANDLES

- Open flames are not permitted in the residence halls, this includes hookahs, incense, and candles.
- Hookahs are also considered drug paraphernalia, which is also prohibited in the residence halls.



PETS

- No pets of any kind are allowed in the residence halls. Please do not bring any pets from home or acquire any when you are here! Thank you.



APPLIANCES

- Appliances are not permitted in AMR I and II, or Buildings A or B. Refrigerators brought from home for these buildings must be under 4 cubic feet.
- Appliances are permitted in Wolman, but must be stored in the kitchenette.
- Microfridge units may be rented from Kingfridge (more information about Kingfridge will be included in your assignment letter. These are the only types of microwaves allowed in AMR I and II, and Buildings A and B.



WALL DECORATIONS

- Decorations may not cover more than 1/2 of your total wall surface area. This is a fire hazard.
- All tapestries or cloth decorations must be clearly labeled “flame resistant”.

THESE ITEMS WILL BE CONFISCATED IF FOUND IN YOUR RESIDENCE HALL ROOMS.
