

Tenure-track Assistant Professor Chemistry - Biochemistry, American University, Washington, DC

The Department of Chemistry in the College of Arts and Sciences at American University seeks a full-time tenure track faculty member at the rank of Assistant Professor for Fall 2012 (August).

Requirements:

The successful candidate must have a Ph.D. in Chemistry or related field and be able to show evidence of strong teaching skills. Primary teaching responsibilities include Biochemistry, Advanced Undergraduate Laboratories and Lower Level Chemistry.

Applicants are expected to maintain a strong research record and secure external funding. Other responsibilities also include supervising graduate and undergraduate research students and mentoring both undergraduate and graduate students.
