

Director of Science, Breast Cancer Fund, San Francisco, CA

The mission of the Director of Science (DS) is to provide leadership to strengthen the Breast Cancer Fund's role as a national leader in science-based environmental health advocacy. The DS supports the CEO, senior management team, staff and board of directors in understanding and incorporating into our work the scientific evidence relevant to the organization's mission to identify and eliminate the environmental and other preventable causes of breast cancer.

Reporting to the CEO, and working closely with the senior management team, the DS oversees all science-related activities, including monitoring and interpreting emerging scientific research relevant to our work, representing the organization in key scientific bodies, developing and managing science-related program and policy initiatives, providing scientific guidance on the development of new programmatic initiatives and ensuring the scientific accuracy of our public messaging and materials.

The Breast Cancer Fund is the leading national organization working to connect the dots between breast cancer and exposures to chemicals and radiation in our everyday environments. We translate the growing body of scientific evidence linking breast cancer and environmental exposures into public education, market and advocacy campaigns that protect our health and reduce breast cancer risk. We help transform how our society thinks about and uses chemicals and radiation, with the goal of preventing breast cancer.
