

Tenure-Track Faculty, Biochemistry, Aquinas College (MI)

The candidate will be expected to teach biochemistry and/or organic chemistry, as well as other introductory and advanced chemistry courses; to develop a research program involving undergraduates; and to support the department and college through service.
