

Assistant Professor Associate Professor, or Professor of Biology, Brooklyn College of CUNY, Brooklyn NY

The Department of Biology seeks a broadly trained biologist whose research will add to the breadth and depth of the department. The research should include systematic and molecular approaches in ecology, environmental biology, evolution, or related areas. This work should relate to the College's initiative in the urban environment, including marine estuaries. The faculty member will participate in teaching undergraduate courses as well as graduate courses that relate to his/her specialty. Development of a strong, competitive, research program that trains undergraduate and graduate research students and generates external grant funding is essential. Candidates applying for appointment as Associate Professor must have a strong record of research productivity and teaching. Candidates applying for Professor must show outstanding accomplishments in research productivity and funding, as well as pedagogy. Participation in the CUNY biology doctoral program is required.

This is a tenure-track position, with competitive salary and benefits. Lab space and start-up funds for research will be provided. The successful candidate will join a research-active department of 17 faculty with expertise in microbiology, molecular and cell biology, bioinformatics, and behavioral neurobiology.
