

Microbiologist, Department Of State, Washington DC

This position is located in the Bureau of International Security and Nonproliferation, Biological Policy Staff (ISN/BPS), reporting to the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Non-Nuclear and Counterproliferation. The incumbent is responsible for representing the office in interagency meetings on issues at the interface between science, public health and security including synthetic biology, laboratory biosafety and biosecurity, professional responsibility in the life sciences, bioterrorism and biodefense.

Requirements:

Degree: microbiology; OR biology, chemistry, OR basic medical science that INCLUDED at least 20 semester hours in microbiology and other subjects related to the study of microorganisms, AND 20 semester hours in the physical and mathematical sciences combining course work in organic chemistry or biochemistry, physics, and college algebra, or their equivalent from an accredited college or university;

OR

Combination of education and experience--courses equivalent to a major in microbiology, biology, chemistry, OR basic medical science that INCLUDED courses as shown above, PLUS appropriate experience OR additional education. This education and experience together must meet 100% of the qualification requirements for this position.
