Re: Graduate Degree Deadline Dates

A graduate student who has completed all degree requirements, and for whom certification for the degree has been sent to the Graduate Board or the Whiting School Graduate Committee before the first day of classes **does not need to register for that semester**. In all other cases, registration according to the usual procedures, including payment of applicable tuition and fees, is mandatory. In particular, non-registration in the expectation of completing degree requirements during a semester is not permitted.

Completion of requirements includes the submission of all materials, including departmental certification for completion of requirements, dissertation readers' letter of acceptance, and submission of the completed dissertation to the library.

A student who completes all requirements for a Ph.D. or final masters degree by the deadline of approximately the eighth week of classes during the Fall semester and receives certification of a degree from the Whiting School Graduate Committee or the Graduate Board at the Fall meeting, is entitled to a refund of any tuition or non-resident fee paid for that Fall semester. Tuition paid from departmental or research grants will also be refunded. **There is no corresponding "grace period" during the spring semester.**

January 22 & 23	In-person registration for the 2009 spring semester
January 23	Deadline to complete degree work for early Spring Whiting Graduate Committee meeting
January 26	First day of classes
March 27	Completion of Final Graduate Board Oral Exams for spring (Arts & Sciences)
April 10	All dissertations, essays, readers' letters, and certifications must be in the library or Graduate Board Office no later than 4 P.M. (Arts & Sciences)
May 11	Late Spring 2009 completers (Engineering)
