Sign-On Instructions for ISIS

(For accessing the Registrar and Other Self-Services beginning July 16, 2007)

Beginning July 16, 2007, the Johns Hopkins University will be implementing the Integrated Student Information System (ISIS) Records and Registration Website. Using your computer, an internet connection, and most supported web browsers, you will be able to register and pay for your courses, view your grades, view your schedule of classes, and make changes to your biographical and address information. This provides a single location to access your financial aid, billing and registration records. With the ISIS implementation, the university moves one step closer to a fully integrated student information system accessible through the Web.

What do I need to begin?

To sign on to ISIS, you will need your JHED login ID (LID) and password. If you don't know your JHED LID, please call 410-516-8082 or e-mail pwhite18@jhu.edu.

When can I begin to use ISIS?

You can currently access your financial aid and billing information through ISIS. Beginning July 16th, you will also be able to access your records and registration information.
