## **DISABILITY NOTIFICATION INFORMATION**

To receive accommodations for a disability, you must register with the JHU Office for Student Disability Services at <http://web.jhu.edu/disabilities/students/admitted/registering.html>. It is recommended that you do so several weeks prior to the beginning of the semester during which you wish to receive accommodations. Part of the registration process is the submission of documentation of your disability at <http://web.jhu.edu/disabilities/students/admitted/documentation/index.html>. Your request for accommodations and your supporting documentation are then processed by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Coordinator's Office. That office makes the final decision on whether accommodations are due and in what form. Please recognize that your documentation must fulfill all requirements indicated in the link provided for your request to be granted.
